An Opportunity to Provide Input into Medicaid Step 2

From Department of Health and Human Services: "Long Term Services and Supports, including those provided through the Developmental Disabilities [DD], Acquired Brain Disorders [ABD] In Home Supports [I.H.S.] Home and Community Based Services waivers are being integrated into the Medicaid Care Management [MCM] program.

Although a start date has yet to be determined for the integration of DD, ABD and I.H.S. waiver services and supports into the Medicaid Care Management program, planning is underway and your input is needed.

On Monday August 4, 2014, the NH State Family Support Council is hosting a Stakeholder Input Session from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. This meeting is being held at New Hampshire Hospital, 36 Clinton Street Concord, NH 03301, in conference rooms A-C.
