

Busy Week at the State House

There is a budget floor amendment (2017-1213h) that will spend about \$24 million for developmental services in the next state budget. The amendment will likely be offered on the House floor this Wednesday, April 5. The sponsors of this bill believe this amendment will fully fund the DD waitlist and a much-needed pay increase for Direct Support Professionals. Two Important NH Bills Are Being Heard this Week

HB 620, an act relative to compliance with state and federal education mandates, impacts education policy in NH, including the NH Rules for the Education of Children with Disabilities (our special education rules). As amended by the House, HB 620 does not pose a significant threat to our existing rules. But – that could change depending on what happens in the Senate.

SB 193-FN, an act establishing education freedom savings accounts for students, which establishes a school voucher program in NH, will have a direct impact on the funding available to the public schools that are responsible for educating all of our children.
