The hearing is on Monday, March 13 in Concord, in Representative's Hall in the State House, from 3:00 – 5:00 and 6:00 until everyone has been heard.


This is the time to share why you depend on services. Testimony should be under one minute and the more people who testify, the more powerful the message.

Advocates plead for money at NH budget hearing. Hikes not enough to ease crises

That was the message members of the New Hampshire House Finance Committee heard Monday night when they held a regional hearing in Derry to begin work on a House budget following Gov. Chris Sununu's presentation of his \$12.1 billion plan.
