

On any given day as you're absently roaming the grocery store aisles or doing the mad dash to pluck a few last-minute items off the shelf, your life is made much easier by David Stencavage. David, who has Down syndrome, is a master at "blocking," an all-important supermarket function that keeps order among the endless array of cans, jars, boxes and other ribbons of color that line the shelves. When customers continuously grab items and place them in their carts, the remaining items that are left behind need to be pulled forward to the edge of the shelf, with their labels front and center. Blocking makes it much more convenient for shoppers to locate the items they need quickly.



And David certainly knows his business. He's worked at Hannaford for over 24 years.

"Without a doubt, David is one of the most loyal and positive people I've ever met," said Carl Provencher, store manager for the Goffstown Hannaford. "He's been here so long, he's a huge part of the team. He's incredibly friendly, extremely approachable and interacts with customers very well. In fact, when he's not working or away on vacation, we have customers who actually come up to us and ask where he is. He's a member of our family."

Provencher, like many employers in the community, has worked with The Moore Center extensively through their "employment services" program that helps men and women who want to work find the right opportunity to explore, develop and succeed in meaningful, community-based employment. He's employed The Moore Center clients in two of his stores with great success. David is supported in his position by his Job Coach, Alyssa, who is always on-hand if David has a question, but mostly remains in the background since David is fully independent and has full reign of the store.

"The Moore Center does a wonderful job matching the right individual to the right position and we've always had a great experience," Provencher said. "They get it right, the first time."

David lives in Hooksett with his older brother, Tom who proudly calls himself David's "sibling parent and guardian." Tom has cared for David since 2009 when he took over guardianship after first their mother, then their father, passed away. He's incredibly grateful for the opportunities his brother has received from The Moore Center and what it's done for his self-esteem and confidence. "David brings so many gifts to everyone he meets and he takes incredible pride in his job every single day he's there," Tom said. "He has great concentration and when he's finished his work in an aisle, it looks just like a painting, it's so perfect."

He's also grateful for the dramatic changes he's seen in public perception of men and women with Down syndrome over the years. "The more people David meets, the more people he touches, and this brings acceptance," Tom said. "There is so much more community acceptance and less surprised reactions to seeing a person who is disabled in the workplace."

"Employing David is simply a tremendous 'win' for us," Provencher said. "His work ethic is top notch and we couldn't imagine our team existing without him. It's been incredibly rewarding."
