MTSS-B Universal Team Retreats Fall 2018: MTSS-B Implementation Fidelity

When Multi-Tiered Systems of Supports for Behavioral Health and Wellness (MTSS-B) is implemented with fidelity, schools see increases in student achievement, attendance, and instructional time, and decreases in office discipline referrals, drug use, and emotional distress.

This retreat will focus on ensuring fidelity of implementation. Established teams may review current action plans and data (Office Discipline Referrals, absenteeism, academic data, dropouts, YRBS data, etc.), and new teams can learn about fundamentals and receive consultation regarding getting started, developing an action plan, and achieving buy-in. MTSS-B Behavior Support Team Retreats Fall 2018: Check Out CICO: From Implementation to Innovation!

The Check In/Check Out (CICO) intervention is designed for students who are starting to engage in problem behavior, can benefit from an extra dose of positive adult attention, and need more frequent feedback throughout their day. This retreat will provide an overview of CICO and what is needed to make it work. Tier 2/3 Behavior Support Team members will learn how to install CICO in the context of their environment and explore ways to innovate and build capacity.

Participants will be given time for planning, learn from each other, and hear from exemplars who have been innovative with this intervention. This session is ideal for teams who are exploring CICO and for teams that want to revitalize their efforts with this intervention. Register here.
