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## **Governor Sununu Asks Fiscal Committee to Grant Full DD Funding During Continuing Resolution**

On July 22nd, Governor Sununu penned a letter to the State House's Fiscal Committee to ask them correct an "unintended consequence" of vetoing the budget - placing access to \$15.9 million in funds for Developmental Disability (DD) services on hold.

The Governor asked the Fiscal Committee to release this funding during the Continuing Resolution that we are currently in as we wait for a budget to be passed.
