Dear Moore Center Community,

We are writing to provide you with an update about Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and the steps The Moore Center is taking to be prepared for the potential spread of the disease and other respiratory illnesses.

Though the Center for Disease Control (CDC) continues to believe the risk to the U.S. public is currently low, it is important for all of us to make sure we are taking precautions to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory illness, such as the flu, which we frequently see this time of year. The Moore Center is following guidance from the CDC and New Hampshire Division of Public Health Services (DPHS) in regards to proper precautions and preparedness measures that are being taken. We will continue to follow updates and work with the CDC and DPHS as information regarding COVID-19 progresses.

What should I do to prepare/respond as an individual?

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use a 60% or greater alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Clean and disinfect frequently used objects and surfaces at home and in the workplace.
- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick and avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Temporarily replace the handshake, hugs, and physical contact with a friendly wave.

We have assembled a task force with representatives from various departments to revisit our emergency preparedness plan and are augmenting our existing germ prevention protocols to be even more aggressive.

The very best source of information on this evolving situation is the official CDC website, which we would encourage you to visit regularly for all updates, prevention methods, and resources. In addition, you can check the State of New Hampshire's Department of Health and Human Services page for New Hampshire updates.
