## **N.H. Medicaid Dental Bill Update**

There have been several bills passed through the NH legislature over the last couple of legislative sessions related to an adult dental benefit for Medicaid recipients over the age of 21. This has been done through stand-alone House and Senate bills, as well as incorporated into the N.H. State budget process.

Recently, the NH Senate passed SB 150 that currently has an implementation date of January 1, 2023 for this benefit to begin.

While the bill got full support from the entire NH Senate, it's being held in the Senate so that funding can be incorporated into the state budget to fund this program.

If the current budget includes the necessary funding upon its passage, the program will begin on January 1, 2023. We'll continue to monitor the state budget process to ensure that funding is appropriated for this crucial benefit.

## Emergency Broadband Benefit



The FCC has authorized the Emergency Broadband Benefit program, but the start date has not yet been established. The FCC is working to make the benefit available as quickly as possible, and Individuals should be able to sign up by the end of April 2021.

It will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible families can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10-\$50 toward the purchase price.
