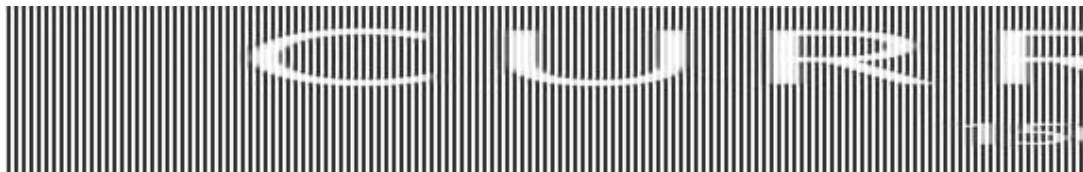

Free tours and galley admission to the museum, live music in the Winter Garden, happy hour drink specials, and a full menu available for purchase every Thursday night!

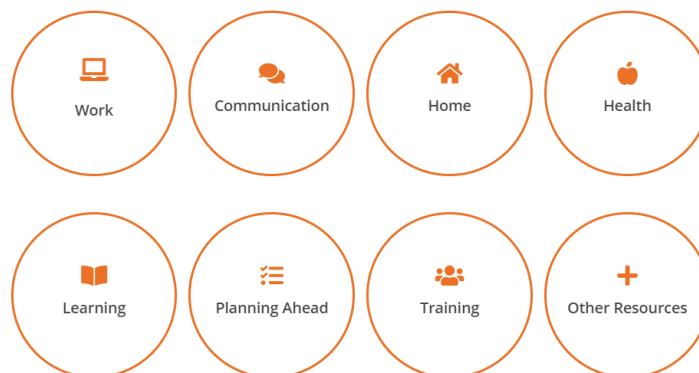
Online advance registration is recommended. Museum members receive a 10% discount on food and beverages with a valid membership card (cocktails and tax excluded).

Requirements

- Eligibility: This competition is open to the public. All artists working in two-dimensional mediums may submit their work for this contest and do not need to have professional experience to participate.
- All submissions must be received by Monday, July 19, 2021 . Selected artists will be contacted no later than Friday, August 20, 2021 regarding the next steps.
- All artwork must be two-dimensional (i.e. drawings, paintings, or photography). Artwork may be created for the purpose of this calendar or may be selected from an existing portfolio of work.

- Each artist is welcome to submit a maximum of three (3) works of art for consideration using the form below.

If selected, artists need to agree to the terms of the Artwork Release Form. Unfortunately, we are unable to feature any artwork without the release form. Please be sure you are willing and able to comply with the terms prior to submission.
