Important Update to Masking Policy

To our Moore Center Families,

Together we have made great strides in our return to in-person, community-based services, and we want to do everything we can to keep that forward momentum while protecting our workforce, clients, and families. That is why we are returning to universal masking indoors for all clients, families, and staff of The Moore Center, effective Wednesday, August 4.

Why the change? The CDC is encouraging universal masking in areas of substantial COVID-19 spread, due to the Delta variant of the virus. While Manchester is not experiencing substantial spread at this time, we are seeing a concerning rise in cases in nearby communities. Knowing how rapidly it spreads, we feel it is prudent to act in a proactive manner.
