Join Advocates Across the Country Tomorrow, Thursday, October 28, 2021 for the HCBS Day of Action

We have been keeping you informed on efforts to have Congress prioritize Home-and-Community-Based Services (HCBS) through the “Build Back Better” budget reconciliation bill.

Nearly one million seniors and disabled Americans are stuck on years-long waiting lists for HCBS. Our workforce crisis only contributes to this situation.



President Biden promised to make a historic investment in home care, but recent negotiations mean that full funding for HCBS could be on the chopping block.

We need Congress to fully fund a transformative

change in our HCBS system. With this investment, we can ensure that disabled and aging people can get the care they need without being pushed into institutions, and to ensure that direct support workers are paid fairly and treated with dignity.

On Thursday, October 28, we are holding a day of action to remind President Biden and Congress that we need the largest amount of funding possible for HCBS.
