We Need You to Contact Members of the Executive Council

The Fiscal Committee voted to accept and expend the FMAP funding! The next step is for DHHS to request that this money be distributed to contracted providers. This is a matter that will be taken up by the Governor and Executive Council.

We're looking for individuals to contact members of the Executive Council in support of accepting the one time increase of FMAP funding for the Area Agencies.



We expect that the Executive Council will take up this matter on **Wednesday, Dec 22nd**. We are asking that you **contact the members of the Executive Council by Tuesday, Dec 21st**. Talking points:

FMAP is funding that comes from the federal government that supports developmental services. It is often referred to as the “Federal Medicaid Match”.

In 2021 the federal government authorized a one-time increase in FMAP, as a part of American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA to help providers recruit, retain and train Direct Support Professionals and other caregivers. New Hampshire’s legislative Fiscal Committee voted to ACCEPT the additional funding on December 17.

Your support of this (by calling or emailing the executive councilor from your district) will help them to know how important it is to accept this money.
