New Masking Requirements

We are continuing to monitor the fluid situation of community spread of the Omicron variant of COVID-19. One change we are making



based on new information is that, effective immediately, all staff, visitors, families and clients accessing in-person meetings or programing are expected to use medical-grade masks, rather than cloth masks. It has become clear in the past few weeks that these masks can provide greater protection than cloth masks.

If you have meetings scheduled with agency staff, please consider meeting virtually whenever possible to lessen the amount of in-person interactions and the potential for community spread. "CDC expects that anyone with Omicron infection can spread the virus to others, even if they are vaccinated or don't have symptoms."
