Important Phase Change Information

To Our Moore Center Families,

As you are probably aware, the COVID numbers across New Hampshire, and particularly in our region, are at a record high, and the coming holiday season raises concerns that the numbers will continue to climb.



In response to this change in the local landscape, we are making some precautionary changes to our operations, beginning December 15. These changes will extend until January 14, at which time we will re-evaluate and decide on a path forward.

As of December 15, we will be returning to primarily virtual programming, with some in-person services being offered for those clients who are supported in the workplace. Our residences will be tightening their protocols around staffing and visitation. Because we serve such a wide variety of people in a variety of settings, we cannot make a blanket

statement about what that means for your family member. Your program manager is the best person to discuss what this means for your individual situation.

Access to our McGregor street location will return to by-appointment only for essential services and meetings that need to take place in person. Please do not attend an in-person meeting if you have symptoms of COVID-19, have a known exposure, or are awaiting test results. Follow this link for more information about symptoms:
