## Important Covid Update

**Here are some important COVID updates:**

- **Vaccine Clinics** - All state-run vaccine clinics will close on March 31. But, you can still access a vaccine at many pharmacies around the state! Here is a link to all of the known sites in NH offering the vaccine: <https://www.vaccines.gov/>.



- **COVID-19 Testing** - The COVID-19 testing site located outside of the Hunt Pool Bathhouse, 297 Maple Street, will be closing on March 15. - **Call Center for In-Home Appointments** - For people who can't leave their home: There is now a call center for people to call and request an in-home booster/vaccine appointment. The On-Site Medical Services Homebound Call Center has begun to accept call for in-home vaccination

services.

We're very proud of the important work we are doing with the Manchester NH Police to collaborate on a year-long training project focusing on police interaction with people with autism and other developmental disabilities.
