Lots of other summer events, too!



Manchester Introduces Public Health and Safety Team, or PHAST

On Tuesday, city leaders introduced the first nine members of the Public Health and Safety Team, or PHAST.

Funded by the American Rescue Plan Act, PHAST seeks to address neighborhood-level health concerns and provide trusted points of contact for vulnerable city residents struggling with accessing resources that may otherwise go underutilized.

The PHAST program also seeks to reduce the burden on police officers by responding to incidents where police officers have been called in the past, but non-police officers may be more beneficial. While the PHAST members are not first responders and are not expected to replace police officers, in addition to reducing the police burden, they are also expected to coordinate with police as "violence interrupters" by using an evidence-based approach to reduce violent crime, treating violence no differently than any other health epidemic. The outreach done by PHAST is a key component of Manchester Police Department Chief Allen Aldenberg's violent crime reduction strategy. (more... read the full article at the link below.)
