Are You Due for a Redetermination for New Hampshire Medicaid?



Join WellSense Health Plan, Health Market Connect, and NH DHHS to complete your Medicaid redetermination, and pick up free bags of groceries from NH Food Bank's mobile food pantry.

Do you need help completing your paperwork? Have you been told you are no longer eligible for Medicaid and need other health coverage options?

Act now to protect your health care coverage when the federal COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE) ends! If you have received a pink letter from NH Department of Health and Services or have been told that you need to renew your Medicaid, complete your redetermination now to avoid a gap in your healthcare coverage when the PHE ends. Even if you are over income, your benefits will not close until the end of the federal public health

emergency.

UPDATE: COVID-19 Vaccines for Infants and Young Children



The FDA's Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee (VRBPAC) is scheduled to meet on June 15th to discuss authorization of COVID-19 vaccines for infants and young children aged 6 months – 4 years (Pfizer-BioNTech) and 6 months – 5 years (Moderna).

Shipment of COVID-19 vaccines for this age group will begin once authorized by the FDA, and administration can begin following CDC recommendations – vaccine is expected to begin arriving in NH beginning June 20th
