#### Here's the message from ANCOR:

The White House's fiscal year 2024 budget blueprint was released this past Thursday, recommending \$150 billion over 10 years to improve and expand



home and community-based services, a significant win for providers and individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities who rely on these services.

Congress will now begin drafting their own budget, but is not expected to reveal any plans for several weeks. ANCOR will continue to advocate and work with stakeholders to ensure that the funding is allocated in a way that supports Medicaid services.

ANCOR encourages individuals with disabilities, their families, and providers to make their voices heard and push for increased funding for Medicaid by using our advocacy tool.
