The NH Council on Developmental Disabilities (NHCDD) will be hosting 2 showings of the movie

"SPELLERS" at the Manchester Public Library Auditorium (405 Pine Street, Manchester).

Inspired by the book Underestimated, the full-length documentary SPELLERS challenges conventional wisdom regarding a group relegated to society's margins: non-speakers with autism and apraxia, who most "experts" believe are cognitively disabled.

As the film opening asks, "What if we've been wrong....about every single one of them?" 'Spellers' answers that question, in convincing fashion, through the stories of eight nonspeakers – Aydan, Evan, Sid, Maddie, Jamie, Vince, Cade and Elizabeth—who all found their voice through the miraculous process of using a letterboard to communicate their thoughts and feelings. As Jamie explains, "we think, feel, and learn just like everyone else."

Don't miss the heart-wrenching stories of these eight spellers and decide for yourself about the power of being a 'Speller'.
