Virtual Meetings on Microsoft Teams

Those of you who attend agency meetings virtually may have noticed a recent change in how your agency contact is organizing the meetings. We have made a switch from Zoom to Microsoft Teams, so that we have a more secure platform for holding our meetings. The Bureau of Developmental

Services conducts all their meetings on Teams and this is the platform you will see being used across the state.



If you receive an email from your service coordinator or other agency contact inviting you to a Teams message, you can simply follow the link that they send you to log in to the meeting. You do not need to create a Teams account, you just need to have access to the internet, just like you do when you use Zoom for meetings. The meeting experience is very similar between the two platforms.
