### Recreational Services Funding


**The Bureau of Developmental Services announces access to time-limited funding for recreational services and activities that enable people to participate more fully in their communities.**

### **Up to \$600 may be available to individuals who:**

- **Receive services through the Developmental Disabilities or Acquired Brain Disorder Waivers.**
- **Are no longer in school.**
- **Do not have coverage for the service through Medicaid.**

*Funding must be requested between November 18, 2024 and June 1, 2025. Funds are subject to availability. For more information and to complete an application request form, please contact your Service Coordinator.*
