On Wednesday May 7, ANCOR will be taking part in a 24-hour vigil in Washington, DC to share stories about how Medicaid is a critical lifeline for people with disabilities and why Congress should oppose cuts to the Medicaid program.

We invite you to join us at this vigil for any time during the 24 hours that begins on May 7 at 1pm and ends on May 8 at 1pm. There will be a rally to kick off the vigil and a rally to close the vigil.

ANCOR will also be hosting a one-hour block where we will share stories about how Medicaid supports people with disabilities, families, and our communities. That hour will be on May 7 from 8pm-9pm. We especially encourage you to join us for that hour and share your stories!

- **Where:** Washington, DC: The pathway at 3rd Street and the National Mall, directly across from the Capitol building

- **Rallies:** A rally will take place at 1pm on May 7 and at 12pm on May 8
- **Story Hour:** ANCOR will be hosting a storytelling hour at 8pm on May 7
